## Guidelines for Designation as a School Western Illinois University

## The University will recognize subdivisions of existing colleges as schools rather than departments when:

- 1. Documentation is presented that this designation is consistent with professional norms of the discipline.
- 2. If applicable, accreditation standards otherwise subscribed to recommend the adoption of this designation.
- 3. The unit adheres to the University policies and procedures consistent with a departmental status, as examples: governance right and responsibilities as well as personnel practices are unchanged by this title change.
- 4. The designation has the endorsement of the majority of the tenure/tenure track faculty in the affected unit, Department Chairperson, Dean, Provost, and President.
